



COMPLAINT FORM

As far as possible, individuals having a complaint about a violation of AfAS ethical or conduct standards should seek to resolve the issue informally at first. If that is unsuccessful, a formal complaint should then be lodged.

Purpose of this form

A complaint may be filed using this form by:

(a)

1. Any attendee of an AfAS-organised, sponsored or supported meeting or event who experiences or witnesses another attendee potentially breaching the AfAS Statement of Ethics or Code of Conduct;
2. Any attendee of any astronomical event who witnesses an AfAS member potentially breaching the AfAS Statement of Ethics or Code of Conduct;
3. Any contributor or user of AfAS publications who identifies behaviour potentially breaching the AfAS Statement of Ethics or Code of Conduct.

(b)

1. Any AfAS member in a dispute with another member, not involving breaches of the AfAS Statement of Ethics or Code of Conduct, but relevant to Society operations; or
2. Any AfAS member in a dispute with the Society.

Initial contact with the ECC Chair is encouraged to determine whether concerns about a possible ethical or conduct breach are covered by the Statement of Ethics or Code of Conduct before raising a formal complaint. The ECC Chair should try to establish if reasonable attempts have been made to resolve the problem informally.

Alternatively, if the Chair of the ECC is involved in the complaint, the *Complaint Form* to be forwarded to: admin@afasociety.org

All information provided in this *Complaint Form* will be classified as confidential.

Individuals who make false allegations of breaches of the Statement of Ethics or Code of Conduct in bad faith will be subject to disciplinary action.
